# 1 DEFINITION

Multi Round competitions are generally those that are run over a number of days, weeks and/or months. These typically include Club Championships, and other major club events, where prizes are awarded at the end of year presentation night.

However, multi-round competitions can also be used for those competitions that are run on the same day, but over multiple courses. There are however a couple of things to be aware of when using Multi Round competitions for this type of event. This is explained further in the document.

# 2 INTRODUCTION

Multi Round Competitions can and normally do have an event of the day, so each multi round competition requires a timesheet and players registered into a competition for each day. See the Competition Management and Timesheet Manual for further details on setting these up. This document assumes an understanding of Miclubs competition management, including editing/creating handicap ranges, choosing courses to play etc.

# 3 MULTI ROUND SETUP

The following example sets up a multi round competition where it is the best 3 rounds out of 6 rounds played, using the following criteria:

- a) Minimum rounds = 3
- b) Best Rounds = 3
- c) Total Rounds = 6
- d) Using Handicap of date of round played

## 3.1 Setup

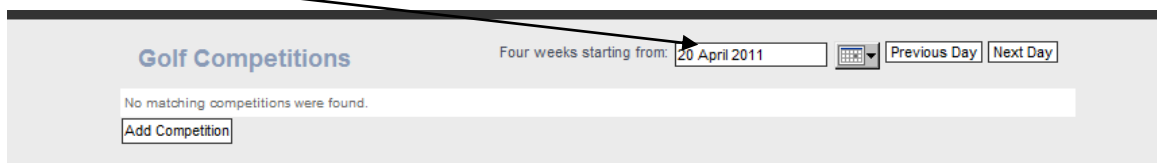
The Multi round is best setup after at least the first round has been played. Then you will have at least one competition to add to the setup.

Go to Competitions/Setup/Multi-round



### 3.1.1 Add a Multi round competition

Click on Multi-round. The following pages is displayed. This page shows all competitions from the starting date, which is the same as the standard competition list page.

- Event Date:** Choose the starting date of this event
- Competition Name:** Give the competition a name – eg. Mens Club Championships
- Competition Type:** Choose the type of competition from the drop down list.
- Grade Separations:** Choose the handicap range from the drop down list.
- Number of Rounds:** This is the total number of rounds a player can play.
- Play Min. Rounds:** This is the minimum number of rounds a player must play to be included in the competition.
- Best Rounds:** This is the number of 'best' rounds to be used to find the overall winners.
- Multi Round H/C:** Choose either H/cap on date of first round, or H/C on date of round played.
- Display:** When you tick the display box, the on-line leaderboard will be shown on the members portal page. This can be done at any time.

The above screen shot shows that this event will be run over 6 stroke rounds. Each player must play a minimum of 3 rounds, and the best 3 of their rounds will be included in this multi round. It is also using the Handicap of the player on the date of the first round.

Click Submit to create the event.

The following is the event that is created. Please notice the round information section – it now has 6 rounds, with 0 entrants in each round. The options of adding participants to each round, or deleting each round is now available.

There is also the option of adding additional rounds if required.

## 3.2 Managing the Multi round

### 3.2.1 Add participants

This view has links to the player and the associated timesheet, it shows their handicap, member and golflink number and gives you the option to delete specific round information for that participant if required.



This leaderboard, shows all the rounds played by each player. Only 1 player has completed the minimum 3 rounds so far – John Digweed. This leaderboard lists all players in count back order. For more detail on each players rounds, just click on their name. This shows the detail of each round, including pars, bogeys, birdies, etc, with a summary at the end of the pages, which also shows the player where they came against the rest of the field with these statistics. This is available on both the administrators leaderboard and the on-line leaderboard the member has access too.

The leaderboard will show the best round of the minimum 3 rounds played, and the total of those rounds for each player.

## 4 Multi Round Results

Typically these competitions will be major events where trophies are given at the end of the year presentation night. Therefore the multi round competition does not allocate prizes or balls to players accounts. Results can be produced in pdf, and excel formats.

### 4.1 PDF result sheet

Click on Results – then choose the report you need – the full field report and the Prizes only report are the two reports that are appropriate for multi round events.

The prizes only report will list the winners of each grade if you choose the number to grade in the following section:

### 4.2 Excel results

There are two reports that can be extracted to excel. The first is a full field report in excel. Just click on Excel and this will produce an excel file that you can use to do further work if required.

If you want the excel to be broken into grades, then choose the option, Excel by Grade
