


# MiClub Course Management

This module is inter-related to a number of functions within the website:  
Course details setup here are linked to

1. Card Printing (templates) PDF and Autoscore
2. MiScore player statistical score history
3. Competition Management score calculations (Hole by Hole data)
4. Competition Management comp submission to Golfink.
5. Eclectic Competition calculation

Course Management is accessed via Competition Management Module (if enabled) in the admin tool bar of the fixture list or the MiScore Admin tool bar.

## Setup of Courses

Click on Manage Physical Course and enter the name of the Club. i.e. Royal Adelaide Golf Club. If the club is a 27 or 36 hole course then it is recommended that separate names are associated with the nines or 18 holes. i.e. The West course, The North Course or Lake Nine, Dune Nine, Quarry Nine

## 2. Create Tee Blocks

- Select the Physical courses association
- Select whether the course is mens or ladies
- Enter the name of the Tee
- Enter Course details
- Par, Distance and Index values associated with the particular tee. Additional stroke indexes are entered at the playing courses stage.

### 3. Create Playing Courses


- Enter a Name, Description and type (Members or Associates)
- # of holes is determined by the tee blocks added to the course.
- Enter Club ID, Golfink Course ID, Union ID (Mens =1, Ladies = 2), Course Rating, Max handicap i.e. 27, 36 or 45
- Start and end times are optional and should only be used for temporary courses.
- Click on update to save details.
- Now Select a tee block from the list and press update.
- Now you can enter additional stroke indexes if required.

Once the playing courses are created you will be able to see the details of each one like the example below. You may edit the course by clicking on the edit link. The register link is future functionality which links with Golflink course details.


\* Note: If course details do not match what is registered at Golflink (such as Par and rating values) the administrator will receive an email after Start of day to advise that a discrepancy exists and to update the course details to match.

## 4. Golf Courses

The final set is to link you're playing courses into final Golf Courses. i.e. Selecting a members course and an associates course together to produce one course.

- Click on Create Golf Course link
- Enter a name of the course i.e. RAGC Members Course  
Enter a description i.e. Mens and ladies Members course  
(Start and end dates are optional)
- Press Update and you will then have the ability to add the playing course.  
Select the playing course from the list and press Add button.

You can add one mens course and one ladies course in one golf course as seen below.

The Golf course listing above are required for selection of courses in Scorecard printing, competition setup (Golflink/Handicapping) and for MiScore stats datat entry.

A course will require a tick in either one or both of the Members / Associates column which indicates a playing course is related.

The course name in this section will appear on the scorecard and course selection for comps.
