

Four Ball Comp Setup Options

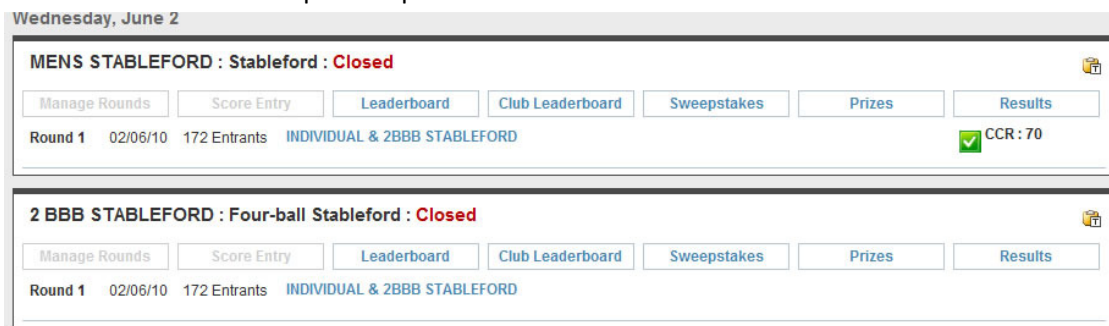

The Fourball handicapping will support these comp types:

- Fourball Stableford
- 4BBB Par
- 4BBB Gross
- 4BBB Stroke
- 4BBB Mixed events

Summary: There are Two methods of running a Fourball Competition with MiClub Comp management module which are listed below:

1. Setting up a Fourball competition as an in-conjunction comp against an Individual competition. (Only suitable for Autoscore users or whereby hole by hole entry is handled) Every player receives a scorecard and the round is played as an individual comp whereby all players are handicapped and play to the rules of a singles event. A fourball competition is created additionally as an in-conjunction comp to the singles event and players are matched by location on the timesheet i.e. Cell 1 & 2 make a pair while Cell 3 & 4 make the other pairing. The software will automatically obtain the best point score on each hole between the pair as long as hole by hole scores are entered for each player (done automatically via Autoscore). There is no calculation of Fourball handicapping score in this method the Fourball comp is setup as GolfLink submission is disabled.

2. Fourball Comp is setup by itself and now can be setup as a GolfLink handicapped event whereby all paired scores that have 42 points or more (+6 or 6 under for par and stroke) are entered in hole by hole either by Autoscore card or manual entry. Autoscore users please note that if one card is used between the pair, the card scores will require manually entry to distinguish between which player obtained the score on the hole otherwise if each player has a card and is marked according to what that player scored only then both cards can be scanned and the system will apply and calculate the scores against the pairing and single score.

Score calculation method: (Taken from Golf Australia version 27th April 2010)

The calculation of whether a player will be submitted to GolfLink to get handicapped is based upon these three rules:
The pair has a score of at least 42 Stableford points (6 up in Par or net 6 under in Stroke events).
The individual player's score appears at least 9 times on the four-ball score card.

The adjusted score (after the below method has been followed to create an individual score card) produces a handicap differential which is equal to or better than the individual player's handicap.
 Handicap Differential = Gross Score – Course Rating.

When a player has no handicap stroke on a hole and their score is not recorded on the four-ball card, they are given 1 Stableford point.

On holes where a player receives 1, 2, or 3 handicap strokes and their score is not recorded on the four-ball card, they are given 1½ Stableford points. When a player's score counts on the four-ball card for a hole, they are given the appropriate number of Stableford points for that hole. When all the gaps in the card have been filled in, the points are totalled, and where a half appears in the total, the points total is rounded to the next lower whole number.

Setup Instructions for method 2:

Setup a comp as normal and select what type of fourball comp is played, ensure GolfLink is set to Yes for submitting scores for handicapping reasons.

Once the comp is opened and scores have been entered, the administrator can view the fourball handicapping calculated scores by selecting the “Fourball handicapping” option in the drop down list at the top of the leaderboard page. The page will revert from showing group nett scores to individual player stableford scores based on the score calculation method above.

When you submit the comp to GolfLink it will display multiple course id for mens and ladies if it is a mixed comp and the list will indicate all the players who will NOT be submitted along with a list that will display the players that WILL be submitted to GolfLink for handicapping.

For mixed comps both mens and ladies scores meeting the handicapping rules will be sent to GolfLink in one process as well.

Swinger Support:

When the fourth cell on the timesheet is empty, the player booked in cell 1 is assigned as the swinger (it is up to the club to ensure that the lowest handicapper is placed in this cell). The player in cell one will therefore automatically paired with the player in Cell 2 and Cell 3.

If a swinger is not required then leave Cell three empty by moving the player to Cell 4.
